I enclose for your information copies of letters which have been received at this Office from the Society's Surveyors at Bordeaux in regard to the overdue surveys, as under, of the steam trawlers "ANNIBAL" and "HEROS", and may say that the cases of these vessels have received the consideration of the Committee and that in the circumstances they have deferred consideration of the same for the present.
