The Second Special Survey No. 3, which became due in August 1922, has been partly held, and in August last the Classing Committee agreed to the completion of the Special Survey and all necessary repairs being postponed until the vessel's arrival in Japan, where she was to be handed over to her Japanese buyers.

A cablegram has now been received from the Society's Surveyors at Kobe, stating that the new Owners do not desire to maintain the vessel's classification with this Society.

The case received the consideration of the Classing Committee on Friday, the 28th ultimo, when it was decided to give instructions for the vessel's class to be expunged from the Register Book with a red line, (12,23) indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules, and the Owners have been informed accordingly.
