With reference to the classification in this Society's Register Book of your steamer "CAPELHALL", I am directed to acquaint you that the Committee have had the case before them, together with a cablegram received from the Society's Surveyors at Kobe, from which it appears that it is not your intention to retain this vessel in the Society's classification.

On the circumstances, and in view of the fact that the year of grace allowed by the Society's Rules for the completion of the Second Special Survey No. 3 expired in August last, the Committee regret that they have now no alternative but to give instructions for the steamer's class to be expunged from the Register Book with a red line, indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules.
