This vessel is reported by the Aberdeen Surveyors

to have sustained damage through stranding.

Temporary repairs have been effected to his satisfaction to enable the vessel to proceed ^{in tow} ~~on her voyage~~ to Ambuch where it is proposed to effect the necessary permanent repairs.

It is submitted the Liverpool Surveyors should be requested to give the case the necessary attention on the vessel's arrival at their port, and in the meantime, the class might be allowed to remain undisturbed.
