The 2nd Special Survey No.2 became due 3.18, and "Examined 3.18" (in red) has been recorded.

The Southampton Surveyors now report the vessel has been placed on a slipway, the bottom cleaned & coated.

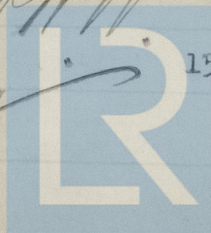
The Special Survey has been partly held and the following repairs effected:— Pintles renewed, gudgeons rebushed and minor repairs carried out.

A general examination has been made and the condition found satisfactory, but repairs will be required when the Special Survey is completed.

The following repairs due to damage sustained through collision & striking wall at Havre, have also been effected:—

5 shell plates, 3 frames, 1 reversed frame & 1 stringer plate renewed. 1 shell plate removed, faired & refitted, & 3 faired in place; and minor repairs effected.

It is submitted action be deferred & "Examined 11.18" (in red) recorded in the Register Book.
