With reference to your air mail letter of the 4th instant respecting the S.S. "EMPIRE LIDDELL", I beg to inform you that the Owners have decided not to proceed with the Special Survey "D" or carry out repairs to the bottom damage.

It appears that the local surveyor to the British Corporation stated that as the vessel was built under that Society's Rules it would be a simple matter to re-instate the vessel in B.C. Class and he has been requested to make the necessary arrangements.

In the circumstances the Owners desire that the notation of "Class contemplated" in the Register Book be withdrawn.
