I am directed to acquaint you that in accordance with the arrangements at present in force for the substitution of Special Periodical Surveys by successive General Examinations at twelve-monthly intervals, a General Examination of the hull for maintenance of class of the above-named vessel will require to be held before the end of June next and I shall be glad to learn, for the information of the Committee, what arrangements are proposed to be made to submit her for the requisite inspection.

At the same time I think it well to remind you that the vessel's Freeboard Certificate will expire on the 20th June, 1946 and you will doubtless wish to arrange for the necessary Freeboard Survey to be held in conjunction with the above General Examination, with a view to the renewal of this certificate.
