Dear Sir,

With reference to the case of the steamer "EMPIRE LIDDELL", I have to inform you the Committee have now had before them the report of the survey held on this vessel at Lagos between July and February last. The greater part of the Special Survey No.3 has been carried out but repairs only sufficient for twelve months trading have been effected. In the circumstances the vessel has now been assigned the notation of "100A1, Classification contemplated" and "Examined 2,44", valid for twelve months, these notations being subject to set up bottom plating being permanently dealt with at the first opportunity. A Docking date 2,44 has also been assigned.

A survey of the engines and boilers was also carried out including an examination of the screwshaft cond. Records of "MS 2,44" and "BS 2,44" have been assigned.
