Dear Sirs,

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 2nd ultimo enclosing reports of survey held on the steamer "EMPIRE LIDDELL" and have to thank you for your attention.

It is noted that the greater part of the Special Survey No.3 has been carried out but that repairs only sufficient for twelve months trading have been effected. In the circumstances the vessel has been assigned notations of "100A1, Classification contemplated" and "Examined 2,44", valid for twelve months, these notations being subject to the set up bottom plating being permanently dealt with at the first opportunity. A Docking date 2,44 has also been assigned.

As regards the machinery, records of "MS 2,44" and "BS 2,44" have been assigned. It will, however, be appreciated if you will kindly let me know when the screwshaft cone was examined.
