Dear Sir,

I enclose herewith original and three copies of Report 10 issued in respect of the survey recently carried out at Lagos on the "Enugu", now renamed "Empire Liddell". Further copies have been forwarded to Mr. Salvensen, M.W.T.R. West Africa, and Mr. Avezathe, M.W.T.R. Lagos; also to Mr. Hooper, Repair Manager, Elder Dempster Lines Ltd. Lagos, whom during my previous visit I appointed to act on my behalf.

I had understood that the visit I have just made was to be the final one and that all repairs had been completed, but I found on my arrival that this was not the case. I therefore made a fairly extensive survey and what in my opinion were the recommendations necessary to put the vessel in good condition; and, according to Mr. Hooper's estimate, she should be ready for service during the early part of January.
