

The Ministry of War Transport (Mr. Fisher) are anxious to have the steamer "ENUGU" No.73539 in the Register Book, classed with this Society. She is a vessel of 1425 tons built by Messrs. S. Harkess & Son in 1920 and has never been classed with this Society.

She is at Lagos and as the war emergency doubtless will not admit of a full survey for classification, it is submitted the case might be met by Mr. MacFarlane, the Society's Exclusive Surveyor at Dakar, visiting the vessel and holding a General Examination on hull and machinery, preferably in dry dock with a view to recommending requisite repairs for twelve months trading as has been done in many previous similar cases for a war emergency notation of "LOCAL Classification Contemplated" in conjunction with an Examined date.

For purposes of this inspection the boilers should be surveyed and the screwshaft drawn unless there is evidence that this has been done recently.

Mr. MacFarlane's journey to Lagos is subject to the Ministry of War Transport agreeing that he can be spared from work at Dakar.
