Dear Sir,

With reference to the classification in this Society's Register Book of your Steamer "ERNIO", I am directed to acquaint you that the Committee have had before them letters received from the Society's Surveyors at Bilbao from which it appears that although several communications have been addressed to your goodself respecting the completion of the Special Survey No.2, which became due so long ago as November 1919, they have not been favoured with any intimation that it is your intention to submit the vessel to the remaining requirements of this survey.

In the circumstances the Committee regret that they are unable to allow the vessel to retain her class any longer and have accordingly given instructions for her character to be expunged with a red line, indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules.

I have to add that upon the receipt of a satisfactory report from the Society's Surveyors on the
