Reverting to my classing letter of the 23rd August last respecting the case of the steamer "ERNIO", I have to point out that on the 20<sup>th</sup> ultimo I telegraphed to you to inform me by cable if the Special Survey No. 2 of this vessel was being completed, and if not how the case stood.
