Copy of a letter, dated 14-10-20, received from the
Society's Surveyor at Dunedin, N.Z.

Sir,

The steamer "ICELAND", (No. 32463 in the February
14th Supplement), arrived here yesterday with New York cargo,
and from reports I saw in the daily papers ^{of} ~~and~~ her having a
damaged propeller, I offered my services, which were declined
as the vessel now was registered in the American Bureau of
Shipping, and the Master had then no intentions of survey or
repairs here. I made no further advance, but reported the
case to Lloyd's Agent, Mr. Denniston.
