I have to acquaint you that from a First Entry report received from the Society's Surveyors at Aberdeen it appears that the S.S. No. 507 recently built by Messrs. Hall, Russell & Co., Ltd. is to proceed to your port where the machinery is to be fitted.

To complete the survey on the hull, the casings require to be riveted up, pillars to be fitted in the engine space and the tunnel watertight door to be tested, and I shall be glad if you will give the case the necessary attention and on completion of the work forward a report on Form 8 for the information of the Committee with a view to the classification of the vessel.
