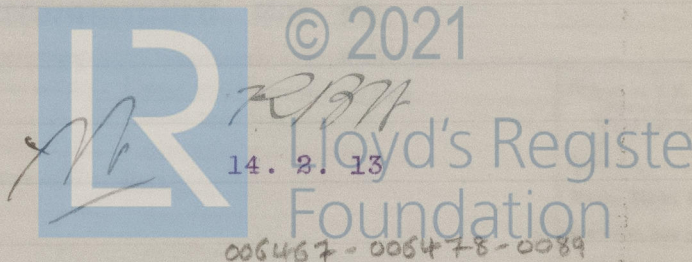
Nature of Survey
