EXTRACTED FROM KOBE CLASSING LETTER OF THE 19th February, 1929.

"BORDEAUX MARU", I duly received your memorandum of the 21st ultimo respecting this vessel and may say that this case has received the consideration of the Committee at their Meeting to-day.

It is observed that this vessel left Tacoma on February 11th for Shanghai, and as no intimation has reached this Office of the steamer having been submitted to survey in America, I have to request you will approach the Owners in regard to the matter and arrange for the deep tank to be tested as required at the earliest possible moment if the work has not already been done.

I think it well to add that it would have been advisable for a note of the case to have been sent direct to the Surveyor at the port to which the vessel proceeded from Japan, in view of the lapse of time before any action could be taken from this Office.
