Reverting to previous correspondence relative to the Hopper Barges "ROCKSAND" and "SANDBANK", I beg to say that I have had an interview with Mr. Embry, Superintending Engineer, to the North Eastern Railway Co, who informed me that the North Eastern Railway Co, had taken these two vessels from Messrs Frank Bevis, Ltd, on Charter, and that he Mr. Embry, had placed the vessels in dry dock for examination before taking them over, he states that what he observed was not serious, but that he was placing everything he saw on record so that when the Charter is completed the N.E.R.Co, cannot be asked to make good these unfairnesses.
