S. I duly received your letter of the 29th October last, addressed to the Society's Surveyors at Sydney, respecting your steam trawlers "KORAAGA" and "MARY CAM", and having submitted the same for the consideration of the Committee at their Meeting to-day, I am directed to acquaint you that in view of your intimation instructions have been given for the character of each vessel to be withdrawn from the Society's Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.

I have to add that in view of the withdrawal of the class of the steam trawler "KORAAGA", the record of the freeboard assigned to this vessel by the Committee, together with the corresponding draught, will also be withdrawn, and the freeboard certificate is thereby cancelled and should be returned to this Office.
