The Annual Boiler Survey became due in August last.

In a letter, dated 29th October, the Owners state that they have decided to withdraw these trawlers from the Society's Classification, and the Sydney Surveyors, in forwarding this communication explain that they have been informed by the Owners that the sole reason for the withdrawal is on account of the vessels not being of sufficient size to carry an adequate supply of coal for interstate trawling, and that the Owners have therefore decided to use the vessels in future only in the New South Wales trade, for which no classification or Government Survey is required.

The Classing Committee had the cases before them on Friday, 13th instant, and in the circumstances decided to give instructions for the character of each vessel to be withdrawn from the Society's Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.
