Enclosed is a letter received by this Office from Messrs. Cam & Sons, Trawler Owners, of this Port, stating that they wish to withdraw the Trawlers "KORAAGA" and "MARY CAM" from Lloyd's Register Class.

Upon enquiry to Mr. Cam as to why he was withdrawing these vessels from our class, he states that his sole reason is on account of their size not being able to carry sufficient coal for interstate trawling, and will use ^{two} these vessels for the New South Wales trade only in the future, for which no class is required or Government Survey, unless vessels go interstate.
