

Steel Screw Trawler "Joule", No. 20206 in R.B., 202 tons gross,
built at Glasgow in 1918 and classed with the British Corporation.

The Hull Surveyors have forwarded a letter from the Owners desiring that the classification of this vessel may be transferred from the British Corporation to this Society. They state that she was purchased by them from the Admiralty, and is of the Strath type.

The vessel was presumably built to plans jointly approved by this Society and the British Corporation, and it is submitted the Owners be requested to endeavour to obtain copies of the original approved plans to which she was constructed.

Provided from examination of the plans the scantlings are found satisfactory, and are verified by the Surveyors, the requirements of Section 48 of the Rules for ships not built under survey be complied with, and the Special Survey No.1 be carried out, and the vessel found or placed in thoroughly good and efficient condition to the Society's satisfaction, she will be eligible for classification in the Register Book.

Drilling will not be required except so far as is necessary by the Surveyors for verification of scantlings.


