With reference to your First Entry Report No. 14 on the new steamer "IOCOLITE", I have to confirm my cablegram of to-day as follows:-

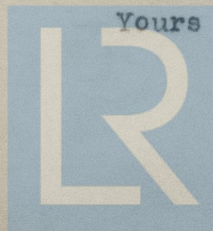
"IOCOLITE CABLE WHETHER FEES PAID LLOYDS REGISTER."
