Dear Sir:-

Referring to your letter of May 24th, 1920, with reference to our Report No. 933 on the steamer "ROBIN GOODFELLOW" and the gear placed on board as part of the spare gear.

In reply thereto beg to state that there are two sets of duplex pumps installed and connected for oil lubrication ready for immediate use, and in addition there is one oil end piston and rod for lubricating pumps supplied.

Turbine thrust adjusting bushes are supplied but there are no liners for adjusting blocks in the list supplied by the makers.

This also refers to the steamers "ROBIN HOOD" - "ROBIN ADAIR" and "ROBIN GRAY"
