have been sustained through striking the Seattle Port Commission,
Cove Pier, whilst returning from her official trial trip at
Seattle, on the 6th day of February 1920.

For further particulars see Pilot protest, who was in charge
of vessel.

On the 6th day of February 1920 and subsequent dates visited
vessel made examination and Found and Recommended as follows:-

FOUND

Starboard bow in way of
No. 1 peak tank & No. 1
sternplate of the 6th
frame space below shelter deck
in the 6th frame space
from stem, and the riveting of
the stern landing and chafing
plates started and leaking in way
of fore peak fuel oil tank.

Shell plate slightly indented
in 10th frame space, and No. 3
sternplate slightly indented in the
18th frame space from stem

RECOMMENDED

That the started rivets and
landings be caulked and that
the shell plates be faired in
place at a more convenient time

The shell plating in way of the
damage be repainted.

The foregoing recommendations were made so as to place the
vessel in as good condition as previous to the said damage.
