Dear Sir,

I am in receipt of a copy of the letter addressed to you by Mr. P.L. Warlow, the Secretary to the Glasgow Committee, with reference to the new twin screw motor vessel "ATAGO MARU". I have visited the vessel with Mr. Robbins the representative of Messrs Brown McFarlane, who supervised the building and Mr. Marton who represented the Builders. After examining the vessel I have made certain recommendations which were agreed to by all parties and the work is now put in hand.

The tank is to be retested tomorrow afternoon or Friday morning and if satisfactory I will wire the result. I have been requested by the Owners' representative to furnish him with a ^{damage} report and shall be glad to know what form this report should be made out on as it apparently is not caused by damage, although it has been pointed out that it might have occurred through the double bottom tank being unduly pressed.
