Dear Sir,

I am in receipt of your letter of the 2nd instant respecting the First Entry Report on the Twin Screw Motorship "ATAGO MARU", and in accordance with your suggestion I have requested the Cardiff Surveyors to telegraph to this Office as soon as the details referred to by Mr. McNab in his letter to them of the 1st instant have been satisfactorily completed.

With regard to your enquiry respecting the proportion of the fees to be credited to Glasgow, I have to say that, as intimated to you in my letter of the 14th October, one fifth of the Special Survey fees charged at Winterthur will be credited to Glasgow account.

It is concluded that the cargo battens in this vessel are spaced as per rule and that the tunnels have been tested as required, but I shall be glad if you will be good enough to ascertain from the Surveyor and let me know whether this is so.


