Sir,

With reference to the Sulzer engines at present being fitted on board the steamer "ATAGO MARU" (Messrs. Lithgows, Ltd. No.762) at this port, it is observed that the full statutory fee has been charged by the Society's Surveyor at Winterthur for the survey of the engines, and in addition, a fee has been charged for the survey of the auxiliaries. The tunnel shafting, propeller shafting and bearings, stern tubes and propellers have been constructed by Messrs. David Rowan & Co., Ltd. who are fitting the machinery on board, and I shall be glad to be informed whether an additional fee is to be charged for this work or whether a portion of the fees previously referred to is to be credited to this port.

I enclose Winterthur Reports No.s 46 & 50 on the case for reference and I shall be glad if you will kindly return the same with your reply.
