Dimensions:- 425 x 57 x 29.83 and 38.58

These vessels which are duplicates of the "ERNEBANK" built in 1937, are being built with tonnage openings, and the Builders desire to be informed if any increase in draught can be given if the tonnage opening is closed.

The scantlings have been compared with the requirements of the Rules for a C.S.S. vessel having a Rule value of D of 38.58, and it is found that:-

Framing:- Equivalent to C.S.S.

Shell:- do.

Strength Dk:- do.

It is submitted the scantlings are such as will entitle the vessel to a draught corresponding to a C.S.S. ship having a depth of 38.58 to the C.S.S. deck and a normal height of tween decks.

It is noted the Owners propose to extend the bulkheads to the weather deck.
