It will be seen that the 3rd bowen including
stock is 2.14 below the approved weight but the
1st and 2nd bowers are each heavier, and the
total weight is 1.2.14 in excess.

Under these circumstances I am of opinion that
the anchors as supplied may be approved for the figure 1
in this instance.
