British World Trade Expeditions Ltd.

I beg to acquaint you that the Society's Surveyors at Hull have forwarded to this Office your letter of the 15th instant addressed to them regarding their account rendered of fees due for the Special Survey held during the period February-October, 1923 on the twin screw steamer "BRITISH TRADE", ex "ORONTES".
