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by hydraulic pressure to 200<sup>lb</sup> and safety valves  
adjusted under steam to blow off at 160<sup>lb</sup> satisfactorily.  
Engines, boiler, and auxiliary machinery tried under  
steam and found to be functioning satisfactorily.

Repairs due to wear and tear:-

Crank shaft bearings re-metalled.  
Thrust block horse shoes re-metalled.

All working parts of engines and auxiliary machinery  
pumps etc all over hauled, generally, and adjusted.

Stern tube relined with new lipinum vitale.

Three propeller blade tips broken off about 10" now  
repaired by welding new cast iron tips.

Boiler:-

20 plain tubes renewed.

New washers fitted to 16 water space stay nuts.

Two bottom man hole flanges, wasted, now made up by  
welding.

Boiler tested by hydraulic pressure to 200<sup>lb</sup> and found  
tight and satisfactory.
