In April last a letter was received from the Secretary to the American Committee stating that the Owners of the above vessel had informed the Cleveland Surveyors it was not proposed to continue the vessel's class with this Society, but that she would retain her classification with the American Bureau, and that the Surveyors had been asked to obtain a letter from the Owners to the above effect.

The Secretary to the American Committee now writes:-

"I have to acquaint you that on the 1st of April, Mr. Ashley, of the M.A. Hanna Company, informed the Surveyors at Cleveland that this vessel was classed with the American Bureau of Shipping as well as with this Society, and that it had been decided to retain the American Bureau class only.

Several applications have been made for Mr. Ashley to express in writing the wishes of his Company, but to date this has not been received."
