She has been laid up in the Tyne since February, 1931, and the usual undertaking was furnished by the Owners in May, 1933.

She has now been sold to Norwegian Owners who are transferring her class to the Norske Veritas.

Surveyors to that Society are now on board, and the Classing Committee who had the case before them on Tuesday, 29th instant, decided to give instructions for the vessel's class to be expunged from the Register Book with a Red Line (—), indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules.
