Survey

The Lst S.S.No.3 became due 4,32 and the vessel being laid up the usual undertaking was furnished.

The Special Survey being over four years overdue the case received consideration on the 9th June and a general examination afloat was arranged for.

The Newcastle Surveyors now report the vessel examined afloat and a satisfactory general examination carried out including the steering gear and windlass.

The vessel appears to be generally well coated and no excessive scale was found in the parts examined.

It is submitted action be deferred.

The Certificate of Classification to be endorsed "*Cargo battens not fitted*" and the same notation to be printed in the Register Book.
