

"EDITH", "ELGIN" and "ECHO".

The cases of these vessels is still the subject of correspondence between the Ministry of War Transport in London and the Flag Officer-in-Charge at Harwich. It remains the intention of the Ministry to have the vessels released and placed on a shipway for examination at the earliest possible moment and the attendance of the Society's Surveyor at Ipswich is desired. If on inspection the work entailed for maintenance of classification should be found to be extensive the Ministry will consider the question as to whether they should proceed or not. In the meantime the Ministry will advise as to when the attendance of the Surveyor is required.
