With regard to the case of the "LIBRA", the first entry report on the machinery has been received from Sunderland but it appears that to complete the survey the safety valves require to be overhauled and re-adjusted and that arrangements were made for this work to be done at Grimsby. The Surveyors at that port have been telegraphed to on the subject.

With regard to the steamer "CORONA", the first entry report on the machinery has not yet come to hand from Sunderland, but I am telegraphing to the surveyors on the subject.
