Nature of Survey

The 1st.S.S.No.1, due 11.19, has been partly held by the examination in dry dock.

The Christiania Surveyors now forward a letter from the Owners as follows:-

In reference to your letter dated the 14th. ultimo, we beg to "inform you that this vessel was transferred to the Norsk Veritas Class during her stay at Arendal for the Periodical Survey. "We have all our ships insured with the mutual insurance companies and therefore we are also members of the Norsk Veritas. "It is therefore natural that we have our newest ships specially classed with the Norsk Veritas. We have had most of our vessels classed with Lloyd's Register, and we take the opportunity to say that it is not because we are not absolutely satisfied with that institution that we now class them with the Norsk Veritas, but only for the above mentioned reason. We have always been very satisfied with Lloyd's Register, which has attended to every-thing in a most careful and conscientious manner".

It is submitted the vessel's class be omitted from the reprint of the Register Book.
