
Dear Sirs,

I beg to acquaint you that the General Committee have today had before them the case of the trawler "LORD KNOLLYS", referred to in your letter addressed to the Society's Surveyor at Fleetwood on the 5th instant.

The Committee note that you desire to withdraw the vessel from classification with this Society, but in view of the fact that the year of grace allowed for the Second Special Survey No.3 expired so long ago as September, 1938, and of the undertaking furnished by you that this inspection would be completed before the vessel again proceeded to sea, they have had no alternative but to give instructions for the vessel's class to be expunged from the Register Book with a Red Line, indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules.
