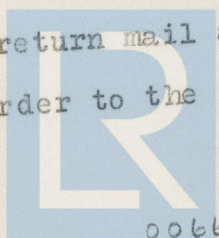

Dear Sir,

S. With reference to your letter addressed to the Society's Surveyor at Port Adelaide respecting the classification in the Society's Register Book of the Wood Barquentine "FOREST FRIEND", I am directed to acquaint you that the case of this vessel has been submitted to the Committee, and that they have found some difficulty in deferring action in regard to the classification, in view of the fact that no definite arrangements appear to have been made for the submission of the vessel to the Special Survey, for which she is now overdue.

From your letter, it would appear that she is proceeding from Newcastle, N.S.W. to Callao, whence she will sail either to the United Kingdom or to a Pacific Coast lumber port, where arrangements are in hand for the vessel to be drydocked and submitted for the inspection of the Society's Surveyors.

In the circumstances I shall be obliged if you will kindly let me know definitely by return mail at what port the Special Survey will be held, in order to the retention of the
