In reference to your letter of 18th ult. regarding the equipment number for s.s. " PRIMULA " (N°1) building by Messrs Migliardi at Savona, we send you the sketch asked for showing the dimensions of superstructures now furnished by the builders and verified so far as possible by ourselves . -

The equipment of anchors and chains is said to have arrived at Savona but the ropes are not yet ordered . -

The equipment number in the first instance was worked out by the Owners representative and the equipment ordered last year without reference to us or to the builders, and the Owners ask if the Committee will meet them if possible by accepting the anchors and chains of the weights given in our letter of October 11th and that they will order the ropes according to the requirements of letter B of the equipment tables . -
