Dear Sirs,

H. With reference to your letter of the 7th instant addressed to the Society's Office at Hull relative to the steam trawler "ISLAND", I beg to acquaint you that this vessel's class was omitted from the Society's Register Book in May last and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal at the Owners' request. To render the vessel eligible for the re-instatement of her class the requirements of the Special Survey No. 1 should be complied with and the vessel placed in thoroughly good and efficient condition to the Society's satisfaction. I have, however, to point out that if the vessel is submitted to the Special Survey No. 1 she will, according to the Society's Rules, become due for 2nd Special Survey No. 2 in July, 1927.

I may add that no survey appears to have been held on this vessel by the Society's Surveyors since October, 1923.
