Nature of Survey .....

(SS No 3 due 1.18 held on hull)

The 2nd.s.s.No.1 became due 7,23.

The vessel is laid up at Grimsby and the Surveyors recently stated she was in the hands of Messrs. Barclays Bank, and no decision had been arrived at regarding the special survey.

The Surveyors now report the vessel placed in dry dock and the bottom cleaned and coated.

The stem bar was found set over between C. and E. strakes and several topside plates on port and starboard sides more or less indented but, in the Surveyors' opinion, repairs may be carried out at the Owners' convenience.

It is submitted action be deferred.
