The Annual Survey of the Water Tube Boilers of this vessel became due in September last, but the Kobe Surveyors now state they are informed by the Japanese Naval Authorities that as the steamer is owned by the Government, it is not desired to maintain her classification in the Society's Register Book.

In the circumstances, the Classing Committee, who had the case before them on Tuesday, 3rd instant, decided to give instructions for the vessel's character to be withdrawn from the Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.
