I enclose herewith two blue forms containing particulars of the fees for the new steamer "DUINO", Stabilimento Tecnico Triestino Yard No.520, the reports No.5897 having been already forwarded to London.

These fees have been noted in the rough fee book, extract from which is enclosed, and in connection therewith I would point out that the freeboard fee of 475.- Lire was noted on one of the previous extracts, for the date of 19th May 1923.

As this vessel was well advanced before the date of the Accord with the Registro Italiano we have only combined 20% of the hull fee and 5% of the machinery fee; the balance being credited to this Society less the sum of 1500.- Corone = 900.- Lire, paid by the Builders on account, on the dates 17th December 1917 and 12th August 1918. The fees have been applied for today, and the classification and freeboard certificates are being retained



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in this Office until the fees have been paid.
