I have received a request from the United States Army Headquarters, New York Port of Embarkation, Brooklyn, New York for "copies of original Lloyd's certificates and documents relative to hull, machinery, boiler and equipment" for the United States Army Transport "BELLE ISLE", whose classification with this Society was withdrawn in July 1943.
