

Dear Sir,

Herewith enclosed I beg to forward application form for re-assignment of Freeboard for the steamer "VENA". This vessel was originally assigned a summer Freeboard of 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " as a classed vessel. When the class was withdrawn at the Owners' request in 1923 the Freeboard was assigned by The Board of Trade in accordance with the particulars forwarded herewith. This certificate expired on the 11th instant and the Owners are submitting the vessel to the requirements of the 2nd Special Survey No.3 with a view to the reinstatement of the vessel's class, in accordance with your letter of the 29th March, 1926.

An examination of the Vessel's erections, hatchways etc., and comparing same with the approved plans show that no alteration has been made from the original design which would affect the Freeboard assignment.
