M. With reference to your letter of the 27th ultimo respecting the cases of the Steamers "RINA" and "~~VENA~~", it is noted that the Owners' Superintendent states that the classes of these vessels are not to be continued.

Under the circumstances, I shall be glad if you will point out to the Owners that in order to retain the present freeboard assignments, it will be necessary for a complete condition survey to be held in dry dock, in accordance with the Board of Trade Circular 1416; and you should ascertain from them when and at what port it will be convenient to have these survey held.


If this survey is not complied with in each case the present freeboard certificates should be returned to this Office for cancellation.
