The 2nd S.S. No. 1, due 7.41, has been partly held. (vessel 20 years old)

The KOBE Surveyors report (2.41) the vessel placed in dry dock, the bottom coated, the Special Survey completed, a shell plate and a deck plate repaired, repairs or renewals to framing, fore peak and after peak tank tops, deck plates, and minor repairs effected.

On account of damage through collision repairs effected to shell plating, framing etc.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed with record of survey 2.41 and notation of S.S. No. 1-41.
