Messrs Taylors have been advised that the three sketches of the ordinary anchors are suitable but that the sketch of the stockless anchor & the four fluked anchor is being forwarded to you for your consideration and that on receipt of your reply I will again communicate with you.

It is submitted the stockless anchor which appears somewhat like the Taylors anchor might be approved, the proposed four fluke anchor is not so handy.
